A RESOLUTION FOR THE TOWN OF EUREKA TO WORK WITH BASSFORD REMELE LAW FIRM ON RESEARCH FOR LOCAL REGULATION OF CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS (CAFOs) IN THE TOWN OF EUREKA

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Eureka, Polk County, Wisconsin, wishes to assess the potential health, environmental and property value concerns posed by the development of a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) within the Town of Eureka; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Eureka, Polk County, Wisconsin, will work with Andrew Marshall and the Bassford Remele Law Firm to:

- Determine whether there are reasonable and scientifically defensible "findings of fact" to the siting of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs), to be adopted by the Town, which address the protection of public health and safety and which support additional regulations on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs);
- To adopt an ordinance regulating Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) that may provide more stringent regulations than the current state standards; and
- 3) To look into the feasibility of a moratorium on the licensing or permitting of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) with the Town of Eureka.
