Clerks Report: The Clerks Reports showing budget revenue, expense, and highway budget for the month of January 2023 were presented to the board.

Chairman Report: The furnace in the garage has been repaired. The sale of the Manitou Ball Park has been finalized. We received over \$43,000.00 in MFL withdrawal. About \$9,000.00 of this is due to Polk County per Wis. Statutes. A letter from our Attorney Johnson was read regarding the clean up of the Woltz Pit.

County Supervisor Report:County Supervisor Sharon Kellyreported on the improved trails and plans for future trails. She also mention that they were working on a new address system.
